



THE CYCLE OF AN ACORN

Acorn worksheet answers

An acorn starts its journey as a small seed in a flower of an oak tree.

As the acorn grows, it becomes heavier and falls to the ground.

Squirrels and other rodents move the acorn.

If the acorn is left uneaten, it will begin to grow roots into the soil and a shoot from the top.

After 4 - 5 years, the acorn will grow into a sapling tree.

The tree will then continue to grow and produce acorns of its own each year.
